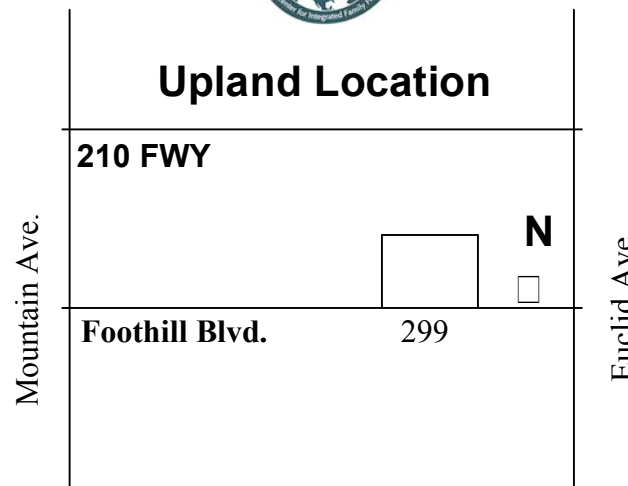

Who is a Nurse Practitioner?

A NP is a Registered Nurse with graduate, advanced education and clinical training in providing high quality health care service. The NP is able to diagnose and treat a range of health problems, from infections and injuries, to diabetes and hypertension.

What is the benefit of seeing a Nurse Practitioner?

Most patients who see a NP report a high degree of satisfaction. This is related to the fact that the NP focuses on the whole person, including their loved ones, and the community in which they are a part of. Using the unique blend of being a nurse and a medical provider, the NP brings care and competence to partner with the patient in making better health choices.

Will I be able to receive my medication refills and my lab orders from the NP?

Yes, the NP may refill most all of your medications and is able to order pertinent lab studies for you, as well as other diagnostic tests and x-rays. The NP is also able to interpret your results.

What are the credentials of a Nurse Practitioner?

In addition to being a RN, a NP is licensed by the state and practices under the rules and regulations of the Nursing Board. The Nurse Practitioner is also nationally certified in their specialty area, as in Family Practice.
